Coordinator of Instructional Supports (BCBA)

The Coordinator of Instructional Supports is responsible for directing clinical services. This individual needs to have significant experience developing and implementing ABA services. This individual will be supervising BCBA's as they deliver these services. The Coordinator of Instructional Supports works closely with a team including members of the residential and education departments to ensure behavior plans are implemented with integrity.

Qualifications: Minimum of Master's Degree in Psychology or Education, certification as a Board Certified Behavior Analyst; minimum of one year's experience with developmental disabilities; Good driving record preferred.

Instructional Support Specialist (BCBA)

The Instructional Support Specialist is responsible for development and implementation of behavior support plans based on the principles of behavior analysis. This individual will be conducting direct and indirect assessments to develop these plans. The Instructional Support Specialist works closely with a team including members of the residential and education departments to ensure behavior plans are implemented with integrity.

Qualifications: Minimum of Master's degree in Psychology or Education, certification as a Board Certified Behavior Analyst given preference; minimum of one year's experience

Group Home Supervisor (Residential Supervisor)

The Group Home Supervisor's main role will be to supervise the day to day residential services for about 2 group homes. The Group Home Supervisor will be responsible to supervise staff working directly in these group homes. They will plan activities and outings that meet the interest and needs for consumers. All scheduling for the assigned group home for their shift.

Qualifications: Minimum of high school diploma; 2 years' experience in human services and previous supervisory experience preferred; good driving record preferred.

Adult Day Service Lead

The Adult Day Service Lead will be responsible for the day to day delivery of adult day services for about 6 adults. This includes ensuring acquisition programs and community outings are completed to meet the individual's interest and needs. This individual is responsible for implementing behavior reduction plans and reporting changes to behavior. In addition, this individual is responsible for scheduling staff to deliver services and resources are available to meet the needs of the adults.

Qualifications: Minimum of high school diploma; 2 years' experience in human services and previous supervisory experience preferred; good driving record preferred.
