Residential Teacher Assistant (TA)

*******Requires two week training period (8a-4p M-F)*******

Working under the direct supervision of the Lead Teacher, and Lead Teaching Assistant (LTA), the position of Teacher Assistant (TA) provides support for individuals transitioning to and from the classroom environment as well as predominately providing support during the school day. A teacher assistant may provide support in the home environment during the school day in the case of a scheduled home day, or if the student assigned is ill or not able to come to school for any other reason. In addition, the teacher assistant (TA) will work indirectly under the supervision of the Assistant Coordinator of Educational Services (ACES) and the Coordinator of Educational Services (CES). The duties of the Teacher Assistant (TA) include but are not limited to:

Essential Duties

- Working one on one with students who have mental and behavioral disabilities in the classroom environment
- Running teaching trials of educational goals as outlined in each student's individual plan
- Working cooperatively with other teacher assistants and supervisors during the shift as well as residential instructors and overnight staff during shift changes
- Helping students with hygiene and self-care tasks before transitioning to school, and accompanying them to all activities during the school day
- Some days may include doctor appointments, or field trips participating in all in-service training required to work with the students most effectively
- Implementing crisis management procedures, to include, but not limited to: lifting and lowering individuals to and from the floor, standing from kneeling position and dropping to kneeling position while physically controlling an individual, blocking attempted hits, kicks, and bites, transporting individuals in crisis state, and deflecting hits from thrown objects
- Cleaning the home: sweeping, mopping, organizing, and other tasks to maintain an orderly home
- Completing written and verbal documentation for students including: information about teaching trials, meals, incidents, toileting, etc.
- Any other duties determined by a supervisor to be necessary to ensure the care, welfare, safety, and security of the students
