Residential School Teacher

The Teacher is responsible for delivering education services for a group of students (7-21 years old) served by The Learning Tree, Inc. The teacher position ensures lesson plans, resources, and staffing are available for the provision of educational services for their classroom. This individual will be responsible for completing required annual assessments, and they will be expected to maintain all documentation required by the State Department of Education. This individual may conduct direct and indirect assessments to develop behavior support plans.
